- 2) a letter of recommendation from two character references (educator, minister, business professional, etc)
- 3) a brief, typed resume of your educational background, including organizations in which you have been involved, community service, educational goals, and the reason why you should be awarded the scholarship
- 4) be available for a personal interview before the scholarship committee
